

34th AUSTRALIAN FGBMFI NATIONAL CONVENTION
GEELONG CONFERENCE CENTRE, EASTERN PARK GEELONG
THURSDAY MAY 13th TO SATURDAY MAY 15th 2010

Planning is well advanced for our 34th Australian F.G.B.M.F.I. National convention which will be held at the purpose – built Geelong Conference Centre. The Geelong Conference Centre is surrounded by 80 hectares of peaceful gardens and parklands yet just minutes from the Geelong CBD and waterfront .Geelong is a beautiful city of 250,000 people, built around Corio Bay and 20 minutes away some of Victoria’s best surf beaches. Melbourne the capital city of Victoria is 75kms north east from Geelong and is just an hour drive or train ride away. The Geelong/Melbourne region is serviced by two airport the Main Melbourne (Tullamarine) airport which is 80km from Geelong and the smaller Melbourne (Avalon) airport which is only 20kms from Geelong.

The 2010 Convention program will commence with registrations from 1.00pm at the Geelong Conference Centre on Thursday 13th May 2010. On the Thursday evening there will be an informal meal at the Conference Centre beginning at 5.45pm. From 7.00pm on the Thursday evening there will be an open Celebration Meeting with the convention speakers. A Friday Civic lunch is planned at the GFC function room, the home ground of the AFL Geelong Cats. After the lunch, we return to the Conference Centre for more teaching sessions and an evening Celebration rally. Another full day is planned on Saturday with teaching sessions in the morning followed by a Ladies Luncheon and a members AGM lunch. The final event will be the Saturday night Convention Dinner held at the Geelong Football Club. The full Convention program includes 8 testimony/teaching sessions over the weekend.

Two of the confirmed keynote speakers at the convention will be Gary Raymond and Jimmy Njino. Both have traveled extensively and minister with a powerful anointing. Gary Raymond has been awarded both the Australian Police Medal and the Order of Australia Medal for over 30 year’s service to police rescue and investigation. Gary has attended numerous critical incidents and major crimes over the years including Granville Train Disaster, Newcastle Earthquake, Luna Park Ghost Train fire, Sri Lanka Tsunami, Hilton Bombing, Anita Cobby investigation and Stewart Diver rescue at Thredbo plus many other incidents. Gary is presently President and senior Chaplain of the NSW Volunteer Rescue Association which is made up of 70 rescue squads and performs 3500 rescue operations a year. Gary Raymond is a passionate story teller and he is an experienced and inspiring speaker and his message of Christian hope in the face of trauma and disaster is not to be missed. Jimmy Njino born in Kenya has been preaching the gospel from the age of eleven. The focus of Jimmy’s powerful ministry is to reach the lost and equip the saints for the work of the ministry. Jimmy’s desire is to help the body of Christ realize their destiny in God and maximize their potential in Christ.

At the Geelong Conference Centre there is excellent accommodation in 3.5 - star rooms. The centre has 42 serviced rooms. Cost of room which accommodates 2 people and included 2 breakfasts is \$130.00 per night. We will keep the costs of accommodation, including breakfast, to just \$65.00 per person per night if the room is shared with a second person.
